Stirling City Centre Alliance has new home

The Premier Colin Barnett today opened the new Stirling City Centre Alliance offices located at 369 Scarborough Beach Road, Innaloo.

City of Stirling Mayor Cr David Boothman said the City of Stirling was pleased to provide the office space for the project team in the heart of the area that is the focus of the team's work.

"The office will provide a focal point for the community to gain information about the project and to participate in the on-going planning and delivery of the city centre.

"The office will house the multi-disciplinary project team that includes professionals from a number of agencies allowing them to work as one team with mutual objectives, sharing resources, skills and knowledge," Mayor Boothman said.

WAPC Chairman Gary Prattley said the opening is an exciting time for the Alliance and the project would benefit from having key stakeholder groups co-located together.

"The Alliance provides an innovative approach to address complex city centre development issues and plays an instrumental role in shaping the future of Stirling City Centre.

"The Stirling City Centre offers an incredible opportunity to create a vibrant, lively regional centre, which will become the second CBD," Mr Prattley said.

The Stirling City Centre Alliance was formed in 2008 between the City of Stirling, Western Australian Planning Commission, Department of Planning, Main Roads, Public Transport Authority and LandCorp.

The Stirling Alliance is a collaborative partnership between the community, government agencies and key stakeholders working together to create a leading sustainable city, dedicated to achieving 'best for community' outcomes.
